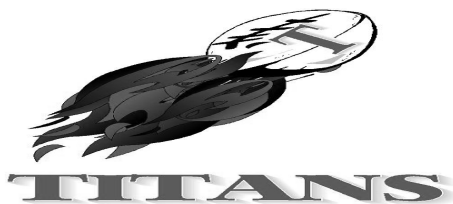

## **PAC the WAC**

Celebrate the opening of the 2008 Titan Football season with PAC THE WAC NIGHT! The WAC is the West Athletic Complex, or the locker rooms at the north end of the stadium. This parent event will be the night before the first varsity game (Freshman PAC the WAC will be the night before the first Freshman game).

Parents - bring your crepe paper, balloons, pictures, posters, scissors, tape, string, everything you need to "do it right". You can decorate the outside of your son's football locker any way that you wish and leave good stuff on the inside of the lockers.

ALL parents are encouraged to attend; we don't want any player to be without a decorated locker. If there is not a way for you to participate but you would like to have your son's locker decorated, please contact your Touchdown Club rep.

## **Homecoming**

Please send candy with your son to throw from the football floats.

A mom's lunch is typically held at a local restaurant on Homecoming, watch for more information.

Parents are welcome to attend the pep rally held at school that day.

## **Friday Feedings**

Varsity players, and those invited to suit up with varsity, will stay at school between the end of the school day and the game. A local restaurant will sponsor all or part of the Friday meal. Over 130 are fed every Friday (coaches and cheerleaders included).

### **End of Season Football Banquet**

The end of the season football banquet is a recognition banquet for all football players grade 9-12. All players and families should attend. Many volunteers are needed to help celebrate the Titan season!

### **Thursday Night Meals**

A West tradition - a parent or group of parents arrange for a meal, typically in their home, on Thursday nights before a Friday varsity game. All players are welcome, and all families are welcome to take a turn. You may want to talk about this with your player. It is great for getting to know other players!

### **Freshman Friday Nights**

Each year, the largest responsibility of the freshman football parents is to provide the staffing for the football concession stands at designated home varsity games. This gives the varsity parents the opportunity to watch their sons play. The set up of the stand is provided by the Booster Club but running the concession stand requires 25-30 people to take orders, handle money, fill orders, grill hot dogs and hamburgers and keep the hot chocolate, popcorn and pop flowing! Hundreds of hamburgers and hot dogs need to be grilled before and during every game. It is expected that the parents of each freshman football player work the concession stand at least once during the season. Additional volunteers may be needed for post-season home games as well. Concession volunteers gain free admittance to the game.

### **Freshman Varsity Game Admission**

In the past, Freshman players who wear their Titan football jersey to Friday varsity games have gained free admittance to the game and we expect that to continue.

### **Freshman Varsity Game Concessions**

As the "Right of Passage" all Freshman Football Parents will be recruited to work one of two dates during the Home Varsity Schedule. It takes 30-40 Folks to fully staff all concessions stands. Since all Varsity Football Concessions go to the LSW Booster Club general fund, the remaining home dates are covered by the other fall sports. (Freshman Parents will also be asked to cover any Home Post Season Football Games hosted by LSW.) All dates and times will be provided in August. (Football always has the honor of working the first home game of the season.)
